We hope you are well and want to continue our project. The pupils in Malm are waiting for letters from the students in Olenegorsk. They think it takes a long time to get contact. We tell them to be patient. They have received a few letters, and some have contact on mail. We work every day with the project and see forward to meet you again. Walfred has a lot of meetings with the school, the students and their teachers. This week they had decided to go to Polen for their school tour. We suggest to visit you with a smaller group. Our suggestion is :

1. Malm group visit Olenegorsk next autumn in September or October 2011.
2. We will visit Olenegorsk with 6-8 students and 6 adults – 3 leaders and some parents who want to go with us.
3. You can visit us with a small group in 2012. The new group of students from Malm will join the project during your stay in Malm. Then we have established a new group who can continue the project.



If you think this is a good suggestion, we can work on with this plan. If you have other thoughts, we hope you will tell us.

We continue our work with different activities for the youth here in Malm.

Next Friday two men from Kurdistan come at our meeting and tell about their life in Kurdistan, why they left the country, the travel to Norway and their new life here. It seems very interesting, and we hope many want to share the experience with them.



Later this autumn we will make different activities/ sport together with our new citizens from Eritrea.

In February next year we will be responsible for a camp for young people from middle of Norway.

The students who are interested will join us. The students who are interested and do a good job in the organization Norwegian people aid, will come with us to Olenegorsk.



Walfred go to Ecuador next week. Norwegian people aid has projects there, and 6 members go to Ecuador to learn and see how the people work, live and which conditions they live under. It is a once a life experience. When he comes home, he shall go to the schools and tell them about his experiences.

Modulf has invited his three girls to Wien the same period. We see forward to this journey with our father. In September we went to Krakow in Polen and visited Auswitch – Birkenau concentration camp. Modulf went with us. So perhaps he visits you again next year.
